



## Leadership Position Announcement

The Chadwick Center for Children and Families at Rady Children's Hospital-San Diego is seeking candidates for the **Director of Clinical Operations**.

### **Overview:**

The Director of Clinical Operations is a senior level position reporting to the Executive Director and responsible for the coordination, operations and quality of care within the clinical programs at the Chadwick Center for Children and Families. These programs include the Trauma Counseling program, KidSTART Clinic, Treatment Outcome Office, and the Forensic and Medical Services program, which includes forensic interviewing, medical exams, and short-term therapeutic intervention.

### **Responsibilities Include:**

- Administrative leadership of all staff in the clinical programs, including oversight of the clinical, programmatic, business, and contractual activities of these programs such as continuous quality improvement, integration of strategic directions into everyday practice, and improve business controls and business operations;
- Oversees productivity and financial performance of clinical programs, and leads Chadwick Center's efforts at clinical revenue enhancement including charge capture, revenue cycle and grants maximization.
- Seeks, in cooperation with Information Systems & other providers, to meet the clinical information needs (EPIC, Cerner, clinical and outcome databases) of the Chadwick Center
- Assures the effective implementation, fidelity, and sustainability of evidence-based mental health services, including TF-CBT, CPP, CFTSI, PCIT, among others;
- Develops and implements program development initiatives for clinical services, and;
- Leads the preparation for and writing of direct service related grants and oversees grant reporting.

**Chadwick Center for Children and Families:** The Chadwick Center at Rady Children's Hospital - San Diego has grown from a community child protection team meeting in 1976 to one of the largest and most respected child and family maltreatment and trauma treatment organizations in the world. The organization is staffed with over 75 professionals and para-professionals in the fields of medicine, social work, psychology, psychiatry, child development, nursing and education. We are a full accredited member of the National Children's Alliance and play an active role in the National Child Traumatic Stress Network, manage the Western Regional Children's Advocacy Center supporting 13 states and host the *San Diego International Conference on Child and Family Maltreatment*. We are committed to excellence in evidence-based, family-centered care in a multidisciplinary and collaborative environment that builds parental capacity and helps children and families heal from traumatic events.
