



Clinician Position Announcement

The Chadwick Center for Children and Families at Rady Children's Hospital-San Diego is seeking candidates for a full time Social Worker I (MSW) or Social Worker II (LCSW) – Clinician with the Trauma Counseling Program.

Overview:

The Social Worker I or II (Clinician) provides therapy to children and adults who have experienced trauma, including sexual abuse, physical abuse, neglect, exposure to domestic violence and other types of trauma. The Clinician provides assessment; individual, group and family therapy interventions; support; advocacy; and case management as part of a supportive clinical treatment team. The Social Worker utilizes knowledge of culture, age, and developmental stages to develop treatment plans and provide interventions.

Qualifications:

Applicants must have a Masters' degree in Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy or related field, and be licensed or license-eligible (registered) **in California**. Priority will be given to licensed applicants who have a minimum of 1 year experience serving abused, traumatized, or at-risk children and families and are experienced in the provision of Trauma-Focused Cognitive-Behavioral Therapy, Child-Parent Psychotherapy, or other trauma-focused evidence-based treatment. The ideal candidate has strong written and oral communication skills, works effectively in a team environment, has knowledge of the child welfare and legal systems, is skilled at developing and maintaining collaborative relationships with others (clients, caregivers, co-workers, professionals from other agencies and organizations), and is committed to principles of cultural competency. Both individual and group supervision is provided.

Chadwick Center for Children and Families:

The Chadwick Center at Rady Children's Hospital - San Diego has grown from a community child protection team meeting in 1976 to one of the largest and most respected child and family maltreatment and trauma treatment organizations in the world.
